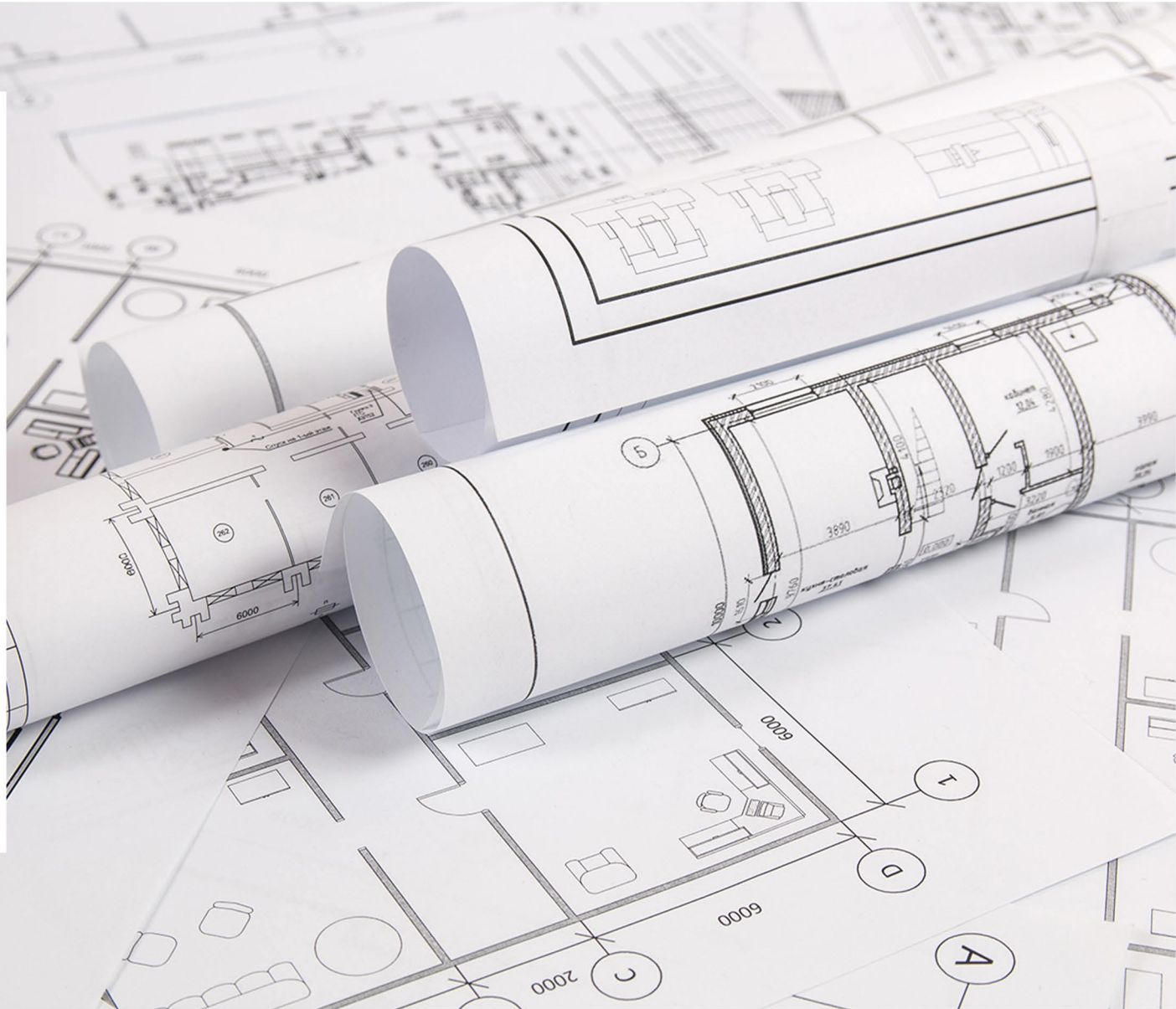


# Floor Plan

Floor plans can be used for planning interior design, for technical requirements such as wiring installations, and they can also be a great tool to aid in selling or renting out a room or building.

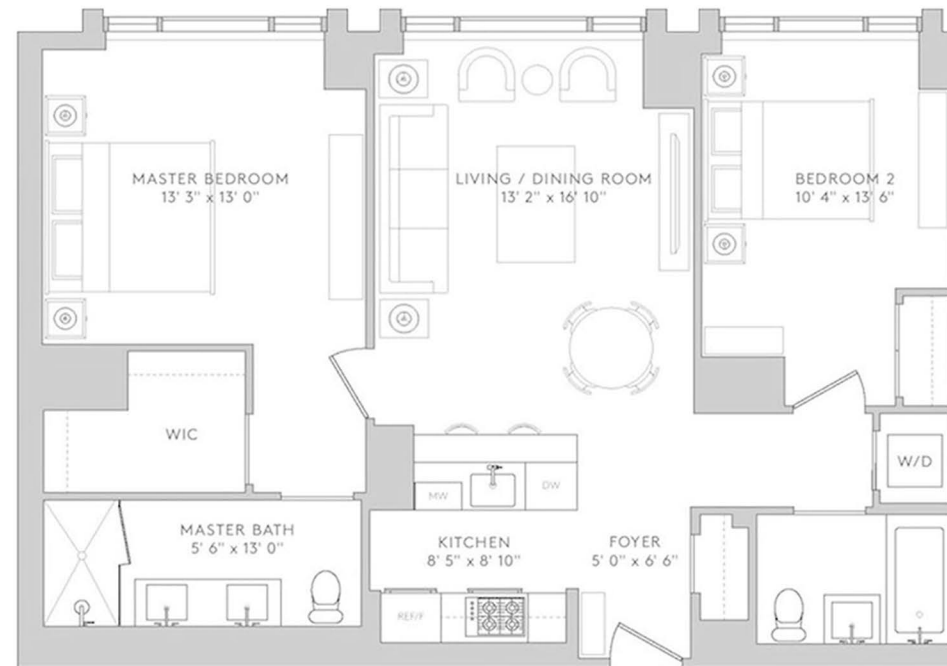
# The Importance of Floor Plan Design
